
And there is also

Rehabilitation

Following a stroke, heart attack, hip surgery or other serious trauma, any resident of Salem Lutheran Home or any outpatient referred from the community may use our complete on-site rehabilitation services. Physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy, and audiology services are all available with a physician's referral. Social workers help the patient cope with emotional challenges and arrange for outside resources. Medicare A and B, other coverage, and private payment are welcome. Salem Home also offers exercise and activities to help all residents stay healthy and fit. Throughout, the goal of rehabilitation is to assist older adults in reaching and maintaining their highest possible level of ability, so they can enjoy life to the fullest.

They spend quality time with each resident, often just sitting quietly. The floor plan allows residents to exercise freely, and group

Assisted Living and Skilled Nursing Care

Residents of Salem Lutheran Home may choose from two options when they need hands-on care and support in maintaining as much independence as possible. Assisted

Living provides daily help with activities such as dressing, eating and remembering medications. Skilled Nursing offers 24-hour care by specially trained registered nurses. Both programs have the feeling of home, with private and semi-private rooms, plus rooms with four beds in skilled nursing. Personal belongings are always welcome.
